Harold Eugene Knight was the 6th of 9 children born to Arthur and Bertha Knight on August 17th, 1916 in Sandy's Parrish, Bermuda.

Harold's work ethic illustrated hard work, commitment, and persistence. He worked many jobs throughout his life including bus driver, hotel bellman, and taxi driver. Harold had an entrepreneurial spirit that led to his ownership of taxis and later 2 popular food trucks, always providing for his family.

On March 20th, 1951, Harold married his wife of 68 years, Amy Darrell. From this union, his children Jeanna Dawn Knight and L'Tanya Knight Wells were born. After retiring, Harold and Amy immigrated from Bermuda to Springfield, Virginia in 1987.

As many know, Harold was a man of few words. He didn't say much, but you always felt his presence at family gatherings. Harold was a proud man, fiercely independent, and strong willed throughout his life. In 2016 Harold reached a milestone, joyfully celebrated with his family, his 100th birthday.

His final journey home to glory was April 25th 2019.
