Annette Q. Davis of Alexandria, Virginia passed away Wednesday, June 8, 2022 from a 10-year battle with metastatic breast cancer. Annette is survived by her husband, Peter Davis, and daughter, Aislinn Davis; parents, Paul and Doris Quinlan; siblings, Paul M. Quinlan (Cheryl), Colleen Russell (Dan), Bridget Quinlan (Mark), Cathleen Quinlan, Kimberly Schworm (Richie); parents-in-law, Phil and Leanne Davis, and sister-in-law, Liesle Davis. Annette was born in Troy, New York in 1975, and grew up in Cohoes, New York.
