



## Arnold Samuel Tesh

March 5, 1942 - March 30, 2012

Arnold Tesh, 70, Executive Vice President of FTI Consulting, died March 30 surrounded by his family, at his home in Vienna of Multiple Myeloma.

Mr. Tesh was an internationally recognized expert in real and personal property valuation and management with over 45 years experience. He was Director of Real Estate in the law department of the United States Railroad Association and testified before a Special Court created by an act of Congress in the largest eminent domain case in the history of the United States.

He was a licensed and certified appraiser and a member of the Counselors of Real Estate and a Fellow of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors. He was an arbitrator for the National Association of Securities Dealers Regulation. He served as a board member of the Northwestern University Medical School Asher Center. He was also an adjunct professor of real estate at Northern Virginia Community College where he received the Golden Apple in 2006, an award for excellence in teaching.

Arnold "Red" Samuel Tesh was born in Brooklyn, New York and raised in Los Angeles where he attended Morningside High School. He was a batboy for the Los Angeles Angels and the Los Angeles Dodgers when they won the World Series in 1959. He was a graduate of the University of Arizona and attended Loyola Law School in Los Angeles. He served honorably in the

United States Navy for six years on the USS Ranger.

Mr. Tesh ran dozens of Marathons including the Marine Corp Marathon in Washington, D.C in honor of a fallen USMC. He was an avid long boarder and enjoyed spending time at his homes in Vienna, Virginia and Honolulu, Hawaii.

He is survived by his wife of 42 years Adriana N. Tesh, daughters Claire Tesh Stoltze and Cynthia Carnes, his grandchildren, Ethan, Teghan, Lena and Hannah, and his sister Lee Stein-Wood and brother Barry Tesh.
