



Bernard Grand M.D.

Dr. Bernard Grand, beloved husband, father, and grandfather, died peacefully on Tuesday, April 14, 2026. Born May 4, 1936, in New York City to Sally and Joseph Grand, he was raised in Albany, NY, where he graduated from Albany High School, Union College, and NYU Medical School/Bellevue Class of 1962. He completed his Internship at Bellevue Hospital, Medical Residency at Albany Medical Center and a Pulmonary Fellowship at Yale-New Haven Hospital. Bernie proudly served as a Captain in the U.S. Army Medical Corps (1963–1965) at Fort Hayes, Columbus, OH.

From 1968 to 2002, Dr. Grand practiced Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine in Washington, D.C. and Alexandria, VA with Pulmonary Associates. He served as Medical Director of Respiratory Therapy at Alexandria Hospital, Chairman of the Critical Care Committee, President of the D.C. Thoracic Society, and founding Medical Director of the U.D.C. Respiratory Therapy program. He later worked as Physician Advisor for Case Management at Alexandria Hospital (2005–2010). In retirement, Dr. Grand volunteered at the Arlington Free Clinic.

Bernie is survived by his wife of 65 years, Joyce; children Stephen (Paige Alexander), Lisa (Robert Mesirov), and Richard (Joan Grand), and seven grandchildren. He was a devoted family man who loved travel, tennis, swimming, biking, hiking, and the outdoors. He shared a close bond with his
