



## Bernard Winston Russell

May 19, 1931 - February 18, 2017

Born May 19, 1931 in Del Ray Alexandria, died 18 February, 2017 at Mt. Vernon Nursing and Rehabilitation Center after a long illness. Left to mourn: his devoted wife of 62 years, Jean P. Russell. Survived by his two children Susan Wolff and John Russell and six grandchildren Matthew, Elizabeth, Sally, Catrina, Cleo and Ally. Predeceased by his son David Grant Russell and son in-law Douglas Wolff. Survived by two sisters Audrey Gallagher of Alexandria and Bernice Guiffre of St. Petersburg Florida. After graduating from high school in Alexandria, Bernard worked for General Electric, then served in the U.S. Army as an electronics technician to install radar around the Nation's Capital. He was a First Class engineer and retired at age 75 from George Washington University. One of his many hobbies was carving personalized walking sticks for family and friends.
