Charlene Elizabeth Crawford, beloved daughter of Clare Crawford-Mason and Robert W. Mason, Jr., and the late Honorable Victor L. Crawford, died unexpectedly from a sudden illness on Saturday night, July 6, 2024, at her home in Alexandria, Virginia, surrounded by her loving family and friends. Charlene was born on June 20, 1967, in Ann Arbor, Michigan.

Growing up in Washington, D.C., Charlene graduated from St. Patrick's Episcopal Day School, Blessed Sacrament School, and Immaculata Preparatory School. 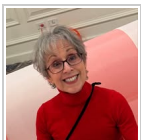

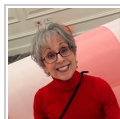
