



Charles Archibald MacIntosh

August 15, 1933 - February 12, 2025

Charles Archibald MacIntosh, son of the late Dr. Archibald and Margaret Taylor MacIntosh, died peacefully on February 12, 2025 at Goodwin House, Baileys Crossroads, VA, at the age of 91. He is survived by his beloved wife of 64 years, Elizabeth Cabell Dugdale MacIntosh; their three children, William (Kerry), Elizabeth, and Andrew (Clare); and 5 grandchildren. He was predeceased by his sister Gertrude MacIntosh Brett. He was a great-great-nephew of Joseph Wright Taylor, founder of Bryn Mawr College.

Born in Haverford, Pennsylvania on August 15, 1933, he attended Haverford Friends School and The Haverford School. He was a 1956 ROTC graduate of Washington and Lee University in Lexington, VA, where he formed lifelong friendships and remained actively involved with alumni activities. He served in the U.S. Army from 1956-1958 and was deployed to Korea. After earning an M.P.H. from Yale University in 1961, he held various roles in hospital administration including in Rochester, NY; Baltimore; and Philadelphia.

Among his many interests were flying airplanes (small aircraft and gliders), running marathons, playing tennis and squash (into his 80s), playing the bagpipes, sailing, and painting watercolors.

He was a member of the St. Andrews Society, the Merion Cricket Club, Pocono Lake Preserve, and the Valley Forge Gun Club among others.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, March 15 at 2 pm at the Church of Redeemer, Bryn Mawr, PA. In lieu of flowers, the family suggests donations to the Alzheimer's Association.
