David enlisted in the US Air Force when he was 20 years old and served in Vietnam. After Vietnam, he work for Johnson pools and was involved in creating the pool at the white house, the tiger and polar bear exhibits at the National Zoo and several other large projects in the metropolitan area. He worked for 34 years for the US Postal Service as a motor vehicle operator until retirement in 2011. From his first 57 Chevy, to his Hemi Plymouth to multiple Corvettes, Trans Ams and Mustangs he loved to drive them all! He also really enjoyed spending time with his children and grandchildren.
