Dolores P. Lynn, 79, of Stafford passed away on April 14, 2008. She was the daughter of the late Christine and Lawrence A. Pluck of Newark, New Jersey. Dolores earned a Bachelor of Arts degree from New Jersey College for Women (Douglas College of Rutgers University) and did graduate work at New York University in her chosen field of Economics. Dolores' career began at the Federal Reserve Bank in New York as a research assistant. She continued her career as an accomplished and published economist at the National Association of Mutual Savings Banks, the Fidelity Bank in Philadelphia, Pa and the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation in Washington, D.C. After leaving her field of economics she retired as a realtor in Stafford.
