Donald C. Yesukaitis of Haymarket, VA, originally of Philadelphia, PA passed away on April 15, 2022 at the age of 79 and was preceded in death by his parents Charles and Ruth Yesukaitis. He is survived by his loving wife Carol, his children Keith (Patty Adolph) Yesukaitis, Brett Yesukaitis, and Lynne (Frank) Stidman, his grandchildren Joey, Connor, Owen, and Grace, and his sister Linda (Stephen) Ripper.

Don was a graduate of Pennsylvania State University in 1965 and a member of the Theta Delta Chi Fraternity. He served his country in Vietnam, was awarded the Bronze Star, and was honorably discharged in 1968 at the rank of Captain in the U.S. Army.

After returning from Vietnam, he met and married Carol in 1969 and had a long successful career of over 33 years at Arthur Anderson LLP as a Certified Public Accountant, a Health Care Consultant, and ultimately Partner in the firm. His work took him not only all over the United States, but all over the world and enabled him to do what he loved most, interact with others.

With a love for sports and thirst for knowledge, Don spent many days in his retirement watching his beloved Philadelphia Phillies and continuing his education by spending time at the George Mason Universities Osher Lifelong Learning Institute.
