



## Dr. Stanley Deutsch

April 4, 1930 - March 12, 2017

Dr. Stanley Deutsch passed away peacefully on March 12, 2017 at the age of 86. He was born on April 4, 1930 in Brooklyn, New York, to Elias and Estelle Deutsch.

He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Margret (Peggy); his daughters, Susan and her husband Jonathan, Ellen, Nina and her husband Andrew and Eva. He was dearly loved by his six grandchildren.

Dr. Deutsch earned his bachelors' of science at NYU as well as his Ph.D. in pharmacology. He went on to earn his MD at Boston University. He trained at University of Pennsylvania in anesthesiology. He excelled in his chosen field of anesthesiology, with academic appointments during his career at Peter Bent Brigham Hospital, University of Chicago, University of Oklahoma, and University of Texas. He retired from George Washington University Hospital in 1998.

In addition to his clinical work he did early research in the renal effects of anesthesiology. He sub-specialized in anesthesia for organ transplants and in pain management. His greatest pleasure, however, was training residents in anesthesiology. He was a long-time examiner for the American Board of Anesthesiology.

He was a devoted husband, brother-in-law, father and grandfather. He loved daily crossword puzzles, baseball and apple pie. Funeral services will be held on March 15, 2016, 10:30 a.m. at Temple Rodef Shalom, 2100 Westmoreland St., Falls Church, Virginia.
