Born at home on December 28, 1917 to the late Pia (Pauline) and Shepsel (Sam) Mirkin in Springfield, Massachusetts and passed away on March 20, 2016 in Ft. Belvoir, VA. Edna graduated from Mayo Clinic PT School and was commissioned in the US army at Fort Devons in 1942. Among other assignments, she served on the hospital ship Acadia in the Mediterranean and afterwards in a field hospital in England that deployed to Cherbourg, France after The Invasion. Following World War II Edna lived in Washington, DC. She worked as a PT at the Anderson Clinic and for Children's Hospital. Later in her career she worked for Fairfax County Home Health. While working at the Anderson Clinic she met her husband Lawrence Louis Salzberg, an Army Officer stationed at Fort Belvoir. They began their married life in 1946 which lasted until Larry's death in 1999. They were active in the Fort Belvoir Jewish Congregation. Edna was preceded in death by her husband Larry and daughter Judith Kraushaar. She is survived by her sister Carolyn Levine and family, her daughter Susan Salzberg, sons-in-law Eric Juda and Jonathan Kraushaar, grandchildren Nate, Joshua, Kim and Rebecca and great granddaughter Shana.
