



Dr. Edward Jay Koenigsberg

of Burke, Virginia, died October 10, 2024. Born May 24, 1936 the oldest of three brothers in Baltimore, MD, he is predeceased by his wife of 44 years Beverly Carol Koenigsberg (Katzenstein) and his brothers Dr. Herbert Koenigsberg and Stephen Koenigsberg. He is survived by his fiancée Patricia Waikart, his son Scott R. Koenigsberg (wife Alexis Wadsworth), his daughter Robin S. Koenigsberg (husband Daniel Grossman), five grandchildren (Alison, David and Michael Koenigsberg and Leah and Adin Grossman). Dr. Koenigsberg graduated from University of Maryland under-graduate school and the School of Medicine. He was in a private practice of Pediatrics in Frederick, Maryland for 8 years. During 26 years in the USAF, he commanded the Clinic at Pope AFB NC, the hospital at Vandenberg AFB CA and the hospital at Barksdale AFB LA, attended the Flight Surgeon training program and the National War College, served on the Joint Staff, was detailed to the US Office of Foreign Disaster Assistance, served as Command Surgeon for the Air Force Reserves, was Director of the Armed Forces Medical Intelligence Center, was detailed for one year at the CIA, and directed the initial studies of the Persian Gulf illnesses. He spent another 8 years with the CIA, first as a contractor and then 5 years as the director of a medical analysis unit. In retirement, he audited classes at George Mason University and then took classes at the Osher Life Long Learning Institute at George Mason. He was a member and Board Member at Temple B'nai Shalom in Fairfax Station, Virginia. Dr. Koenigsberg will be buried at the King David Memorial Gardens.
