Elizabeth Lynd Scott, 93, passed away at the Fairfax Retirement Community, Fort Belvoir, Virginia. on Wednesday, Oct. 22, 2014.

"Lys" lived in Alexandria, Virginia area for many years as well as being a part time resident of Crescent Beach, Florida, since 1976. As a military wife she also lived in Washington, DC, Palo Alto, California, Ogden Utah, Falls Church, Virginia, Beaugency, France, Strasberg Kaserne, Germany, and West Point, USMA, New York.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Major General Thomas H. Scott, Jr. She was born Sept. 23, 1921 in Birmingham, Michigan.
