



## Gay Nell Johnson Lundy

October 2, 1933 - October 26, 2016

Gay Nell Johnson Lundy, 83, of Alexandria, VA died on Wednesday, October 26, 2016, after a long battle against Alzheimer's disease. 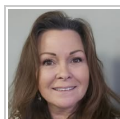

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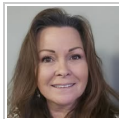
