October 24, 1921 - March 27, 2015

On March 27, 2015, Glenn Rounsevell ended his battle with cancer and Parkinson's at his Falls Church, VA home surrounded by family. Married to Ann for 66 years, Glenn was the father of five Patti (Ken Labowitz), Nancy (Steve Rodemann), Kay (Jim Lewis), Glenda, & Jim (Carol O'Connor). Grandfather of twelve, great grandfather of six. Black Hills South Dakota native, star athlete, WWII European theater pilot, Vanderbilt and Wisconsin graduate. Foreign Service Officer (Madrid & Can Tho SVN), greenhouse farmer, electronic ID innovator, international home builder, owner of Flint Hill Prep, founding member Tyson's Rotary, and french fry vending machine entrepreneur. Agency officer, "husband" to fifty evacuees (Glenn left Saigon on one of the last helicopters off the US Embassy roof at the fall of SVN). Sponsor of Vietnamese refugees, international philanthropist, patriot. 93 year old speed bag enthusiast. Memorial 2:00 pm Wednesday, April 1, Columbia Baptist Church, 103 West Columbia Street, Falls Church. Burial later at Arlington National Cemetery.
