



## Gus James Coutlakis

February 13, 1931 - July 11, 2018

Coutlakis, Gus J., 87 of McLean, Virginia, died July 11, 2018. He was a retired Air Force officer who served in Vietnam and later was stationed at the Pentagon. When he retired from the military, he had a long career as a stockbroker. He was the son of Greek immigrants who settled in Asheville, North Carolina.
