



## Henry Harold Bishop

June 20, 1943 - May 11, 2021

Captain Henry Harold Bishop (Harry), II, USN (Retired) went to be with the Lord on May 11, 2021 after a battle with Alzheimer's at Fairfax Hospital.

Harry was born June 20, 1943 in Warrensburg, Missouri to Captain Henry Harold, USN and Nancy Ellen (Moreland) Bishop. He graduated from Archbishop John Carroll High School, Washington, DC, class of 1961 and then graduated from Notre Dame University, in South Bend, IN., class of 1965. Harry served in the United States Navy as a Supply Corp Officer for 26 years of active duty, including two tours of duty in Vietnam. He completed a Master's Degree from George Washington University in 1970 and a Master's Degree from the Armed Forces (ICAF) in 1981. Upon retirement from the USN, he worked for General Dynamics and Systems Analysts and Financial Experts, Inc for a total of 18 years. Harry married Rosemary Russo on April 7, 1973. He is survived by Rosemary, his daughter, Nancy Jean Bishop Gordon, his brothers, Steve and Jeff Bishop and two grandchildren, Brandon and Isabella Radinsky.

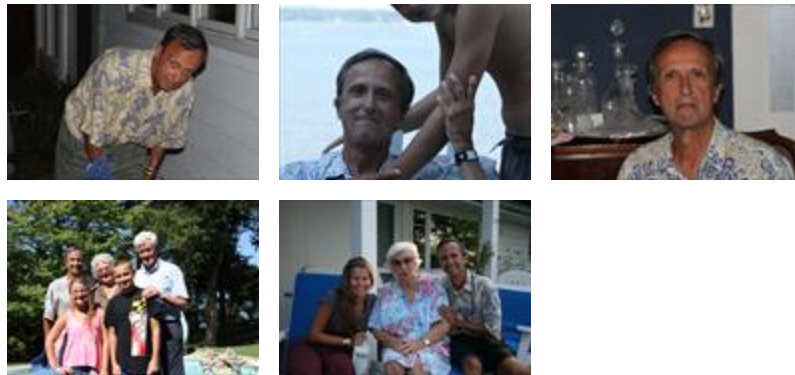

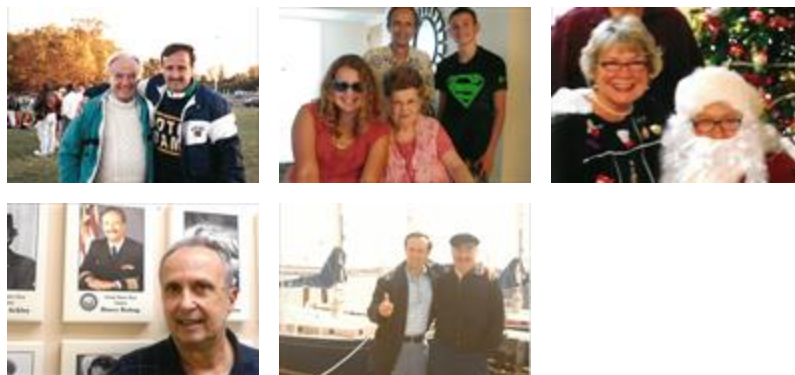
