Henry F. Epstein of Vienna, Virginia, died February 22, 2011. Mr. Epstein is survived by his wife, Harriet; four children Marshall, Susan & Sean Epstein, and Linda Herer (Larry); two grandchildren Valerie and Ty Herer; and a sister Judith Glazer. Mr. Epstein was born in Boston, Massachusetts. He served in the 79th (Cross of Lorraine) Army Division in World War II, receiving many military medals and honors, including the Purple Heart and Bronze Star. Mr. Epstein was actively involved in numerous veterans' organizations. He was a past Department Commander of the Jewish War Veterans of the District of Columbia. He had a long career as an Examiner in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. Mr. Epstein was a charter member of Temple Rodef Shalom in Falls Church, Virginia, and also a member of Kol Ami, the Northern Virginia Reconstructionist Community.
