John Noblet passed away peacefully at home on June 8.

John James Noblet, 95, was born in New Bedford Massachusetts to Lillian Bauer Noblet and John James Noblet. He attended Fairhaven High School in Fairhaven, Massachusetts.

John met Doris, his wife of 72 years, in 1947 in Rhode Island and the couple relocated to Arlington Virginia in 1950. John enlisted in the Navy in 1951 and served proudly in the Navy Reserve (Seabees) for 36 years, achieving the rank of Builder Chief. John was a longtime civil servant, starting in the 1950s as a carpenter with the General Services Administration and eventually moved into building management. He managed buildings in the federal triangle for many years. He retired as one of the building managers at the Pentagon. John enjoyed fishing throughout his life. After retirement he spent many weeks at Solomons Island, Maryland camping, crabbing, and fishing. John was a longtime member of the Cribbage Critters grassroots club.

John was preceded in death by his brother Earl Noblet, sister Louise Robert, and daughter Suzanne Louise.

He is survived by his wife Doris, son Jeff (Kathy), daughter Betsy Jones (Ron) and son William. John is also survived by seven grandchildren and four great

grandchildren.
