



Kenneth Plumb

July 9, 1930 - March 29, 2025

Kenneth Frederick Plumb, 94, died peacefully on March 29, 2025, in Springfield, Virginia. He was born in Buffalo, New York, to the late Clarence and Charline Klein Plumb and is survived by his loving wife of 44 years, Sarah Koerner Plumb. He was a graduate of Amherst Central High School and the University of Buffalo School of Law.

After serving in the Navy during the Korean War, Ken moved to Washington DC and became a Trial Attorney with the Federal Power Commission. In 1971 he became Secretary of that agency. He later became Secretary of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, a member of the Senior Executive Service, and Executive Director of that agency. He retired in 1990.

Kenneth was an avid runner, competing in high school, college, Buffalo Track Club, Potomac Valley Seniors, and with a team of U.S. Navy runners at 1-mile, 2-mile, and 10 kilometers over 45 years.

Kenneth's life was rich in kindness and service. In 1994 he attended the Fairfax County Criminal Justice Academy for six months. He then became an Auxiliary Police Officer with the Vienna, Virginia Police Department. He enjoyed serving for 16 years and retired in 2011.

Kenneth was predeceased by his first wife, Joyce Altpeter, and his daughter

Sarah Lynn Frederick.
