Born and raised in Springfield, Kevin was a proud West Springfield Spartan and an active Boy Scout, always ready for the next adventure or to show off his expert knot-tying skills-often while sporting one of his legendary tie-dye shirts. He was the heartbeat of every gathering, the first to suggest a spontaneous road trip, often to see his favorite blue grass artist, Billy Strings.

Kevin's love for the Nats and Redskins was infectious, and his sports banter was matched only by his passion for grilling up the perfect food for any occasion or sharing stories from his travels. He collected friends everywhere he went, and his laughter-loud, genuine, and a little mischievous-could turn any day around and nobody could "harsh his mellow."

Though our hearts are heavy, we know Kevin is off somewhere, painting the clouds, swapping music recommendations with the angels, and still debating

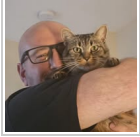
