“ *Kiều Oanh Tống Cunnion passed away on August 3, 2018 in Bethesda, Maryland. With the courage and passion of a dragon, Oanh imbued each person she touched with a little bit of her fire. Oanh was born in Huế, during a time of political uncertainty and war. While still a young woman, she took up the mantle of matriarch and spent her lifetime guiding, caring, and loving her family and friends with a ferocity and generosity that, now with her passing, is painfully absent. Beginning with her work with the Boy Scouts in Việt Nam, Oanh's compassionate nature manifested across the globe. Her unique blend of strong will and soft heart guided her work as a grammar school teacher in Việt Nam, translator during the War, Montessori teacher in Hawai'i, USAID volunteer in Bangkok, and teaching assist at Harmony Hills Elementary School. Oanh is survived by her husband, Stephen; her children Anh Thu, Linh Dan, Jeff, and Leah; her grandchildren; and her sisters, Phụng, Liên, Châu, Mai, Thu, Hạnh, and Hiền. A funeral service will be held at Jefferson Funeral Chapel in Alexandria, VA on Thursday, August 9, from 1-2 p.m., followed by a viewing from 3-7 p.m. The family will receive family and friends at Oanh's house in Glenmont, MD on August 10 starting at 10 a.m.*
