August 9, 1919 - October 25, 2016

Mr. (U) Kyin Oo, 97, a retired news announcer/broadcaster and political analyst at the Voice of America, Burmese Service, died peacefully at home in Springfield, VA on October 25, 2016. He and his voice were widely recognized in Burma and he retained a passionate interest in news, politics and journalism. He was an active member of Calvary Baptist Church, Washington, D.C.

He survived his beloved wife, Khin Thein Han of 16 years. He leaves an enduring legacy of four children, Cleo, Theodore, Winsome and Thiri; six grandchildren, Zachariah, Bryana, Derek, Joshua, Jordan and Daniel; and one great-granddaughter Eliza.

The viewing will be held at Jefferson Funeral Chapel, 5755 Castlewellan Drive, Alexandria, VA 22315 on Monday, November 7, 2016 at 12 Noon, followed by the funeral service at 1 pm in Burmese and English.
