I remember him playing with all the kids in the pool all the time. One year for 4th of July he bought a firework boat and put it in the pool while all us kids watched. The boat started shooting off fireworks then turned right around and burnt a hole in the pool liner. But dad just laughed. He didn't care, he just wanted us to have a good time. And he always did.

I remember him coaching my baseball teams and playing catch in the yard with him. I remember him always comforting us whenever we had a bad day. He always knew what to say to make us feel better. I remember him yelling at the top of his lungs at the doctors when I was in the hospital and they didn't think I was going to make it. I remember working on the yard and trimming bushes with him. I remember working on the pool and putting in chlorine and tablets in the skimmer basket with him. I remember finding snakes in the pool and he would put them in a bucket and we would walk

miles to the swamp at Huntley Meadows and set them free there. I remember all our vacation trips to the beach with him. I remember only he and I would go out past the breakers and just enjoy the calm water. I remember him getting down in the sand building sand castles when Bradley was little. I remember him swinging Bradley on the swing out in the front yard. I remember how proud he was when I got all my baseball trophies. I have so many good memories with him that I will treasure forever. I just wish we could've made more...

I'm going to miss him so much.. every day, every minute, every single second. I can't imagine continuing my life without him. But I know he wouldn't want me to stop living my life or spend my life crying or sad. I will hopefully and eventually get past this with his help and guidance from above. I may get past this but will never be the same, I've lost my best friend and feel like a piece of me is gone too. There are so many different feelings I don't know how to feel.

But my dad taught me so many things including unconditional love and acceptance. He never had arguments or fights with anyone and I am going to follow in his footsteps to do the same.

Dad, if you can hear me I just want to say I love you so much and will try to make you proud. As I know you will be watching from Heaven, I will always try to look for the positive in every situation I'm faced with in the future. You still mean the world to me and I thank you so much for being the absolute best dad and friend I've ever had...
