LaVonne Albrecht Herring, 90, beloved wife of the late Col. William A. Herring, Sr., mother of Toni Herring of Alexandria, VA, and William A. Herring, Jr. of Valparaiso, IN, passed away at her home in Alexandria, VA, on 28 October 2012 with family at her side.

She was born 10 February 1922 to Gus and Penny Albrecht in Brunswick where she attended Brunswick Elementary School and Brunswick High. After graduating in 1940, LaVonne went on to receive a scholarship in voice to Kirksville State Teacher's College.

She and Bill Herring eloped in November 1941, and she became an Army Wife when Bill became a career officer in the U. S. Army during WWII. Over the years she lived in many places in the U.S. and overseas. One tour of duty LaVonne especially enjoyed was 3 years in Stuttgart, Germany, where she was able to visit many European countries with her family.

In her lifetime, LaVonne taught piano and voice; had a career in Government Service; played excellent piano and skilled tennis; knit many sweaters, and tap danced well into her seventies. During her retirement she and her husband traveled to many places including Fiji, Australia, South America, New Zealand, Russia and throughout the U.S. She enjoyed the company of a

diverse group of friends and acquaintances. LaVonne was truly loved and will be sorely missed by everyone who knew her.

She is survived by her 2 children, 6 grandchildren, and 6 great grandchildren; two nephews, 2 nieces and their children and grandchildren.

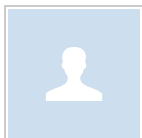
