Then she got her bachelor's degree from George Mason University in Government and International Politics. All her degrees were completed while she was working outside the home and caring for her family.

Lisa's last position was as a manager in the Civil Rights Division of the US Department of Justice.

Lisa was also a successful athlete. She completed 19 Marine Corps Marathons. Her car has a "Marathon Mom" bumper sticker, of which she was very proud.

From the time of her salvation at age 10, Lisa remained steadfast in her religious beliefs, her church attendance, and her belief in a homecoming with God in the afterlife. She is home now, and if even one of us holds her in our hearts and memory, she is alive.
