



Lois A. Tyson

July 23, 1927 - February 16, 2014

Lois Ethelyn Tyson (nee Askew), 86, a retired Realtor, died peacefully on February 16 in her home, surrounded by loved ones, in the Franconia section of Fairfax County, Virginia. She died from health complications due to pneumonia.

Mrs. Tyson and her husband operated Herb Tyson Realty in the Rose Hill Shopping center, from the mid-1960s to the mid-1980s. In the 1950s, she had worked for Duncan and Gifford Realty, in Norfolk, Virginia. In the 1940s, she worked for the Department of the Navy as a teletype operator. In the mid-1940s, Lois also sang for the USO, during World War II.

Mrs. Tyson was born in at Norfolk General Hospital, in Norfolk, Virginia in 1927. She was married briefly to Thomas F. Toby in 1946, and lived in Norfolk, and for a while in San Diego, California. In 1949, she married Herb Tyson, and lived in Norfolk and Jacksonville, Florida, and moved to Alexandria, Virginia in 1961. From the early 1970s until 1986, Lois and Herb also resided part-time in Fort Pierce, Florida. In the 1987, they relocated to Hampton, Virginia. In 2005, they relocated a final time to the Franconia area, where they shared a home with their daughter Sharon who cared for them until their passing.

In the prime of her life, you would find Lois fishing, cooking, sewing, crocheting, playing cards, enjoying her Grandchildren, traveling up and down the east coast, and telling stories of her youth & living on a houseboat.

Anyone she met instantly became family and most people ended up calling her Grandma. Her life's mission was to take care of everyone, and she did it

well.

Mrs. Tyson is survived by her children, Tom Tyson, Sharon Blackwell, and Herb Tyson, III. She is also survived by 7 grandchildren and 16 great grandchildren. She was predeceased by one son, one granddaughter and two great grandsons. Her husband, Herb Tyson, died in 2007. Her sister, Linda A. Jones, died in 1984, and her brother Reuben S. Askew, died in 2003. Mom, Grandma, Great-Grandma, Lois, Mrs. Tyson, no matter who she was called—she will be deeply missed.

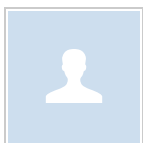
