Lorelle Rodney Melton Fisher, 96, went home to be with Jesus, October 30, 2021 at 5:30 P.M. She was born September 9, 1925 in Culpepper, VA.

A longtime resident of Alexandria, Virginia, Lorelle resided in The Health Center at The Hermitage NOVA at the time of her death.

She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 73 years, Charles Ardell Fisher. Also waiting with Jesus are her parents, John Lynwood and Clarice Smith Melton, her brother, James Robert (Bobby) Melton and sister, Kathleen Melton Counselman. She is survived by many nieces and nephews.
