After her children were older, Margaret worked for sixteen years at the National Orthopedic Hospital in Alexandria, first as a volunteer and then as an employee. In 1998 Julius and Margaret moved into the Greenspring Village Retirement Community in Springfield.

Margaret loved being with family and friends. She was the heart of her family,

actively keeping in touch with everyone. As those who knew her can attest, she was kind, understanding, generous and had a wonderful, witty sense of humor. A devout Christian, she was an active member of a Lutheran Church in every one of the many communities in which she lived, including over 50 years at St. John's Lutheran Church in Franconia.
