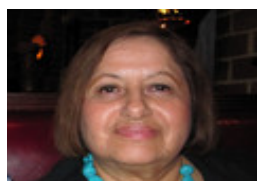


There was so much to see at the Sixth Floor Museum in Dallas. All that history was right there before us. We both felt like we were transported back to 11-22-63.
