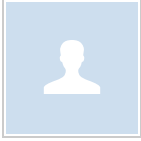

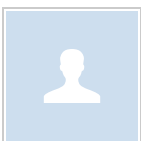
“ Faye, Monica, Wilma and Sheila I wish I didn't live 5 hours away or I
