Maurice G. Stack (Age 78)

On Saturday, May 30, 2009 of Lake Ridge, VA. Retired Air Force Officer and Real Estate Broker, died of cancer at the Goodwin House in Alexandria, VA. Born in Troy, NY, he grew up in Watervliet, NY and graduated from LaSalle institute of Troy. An Undergraduate Degree in Economics was earned at Siena College, Loudonville, NY where he was elected Captain of the Varsity Soccer Team and Co-Captain of the Baseball Team. He received his Masters Degree from George Washington University. Mr. Stack was graduated and commissioned from the USAF Aviation Cadet Program. Flying assignments include the Military Air Transport Service (MATS), Air Rescue Service and the Air Training Command. Overseas assignments were in Greenland, Vietnam and Soviet Union where he served as Air Attache. Following Air Force Retirement, he pursued a second career in Real Estate and later as Manager/Consultant for Panorama Real Estate, Mount Vernon Realty and, more recently, with Avery-Hess Realtors, all in the Springfield/Burke area. A longtime resident of Mason Neck, Mr. Stack divided his time between Virginia and Fourt Myers Beach, Florida. He attended Mass at Good Shepherd Roman Catholic Church. Survivors include his wife, Karin L. Stack; two sons, Martin P. Stack of Atlanta, GA and Andrew M. Stack of Park City, UT and Washington D.C.; two granddaughters, Nola D. and Erin S. Stack. Funeral service will be held at Ft. Myer Old Post Chapel, Thursday, September 10, 2009 at 10:45 am. Interment will follow at Arlington National Cemetery. In lieu of flowers,
