Mike (57) passed away on December 6, 2012 at home in Springfield, VA. Mike was born in Oklahoma City, OK on May 24, 1955, attended the American School in Brussels, Belgium for 4 years prior to his senior year graduation at T.C. Williams High School in Alexandria before beginning a 29 year career as a certified arborist with JL Tree Service. Mike was an avid outdoorsman, biker, hiker, bee keeper, sky diver, gardener and a life long blood donor for the American Red Cross. He also participated at St Lawrence's Christian Youth Organization, volunteered at Virginia's Prison Ministry and Christmas in April. He is survived by his wife, Debra Mayeux; step-daughters Leslie Simpson and Amy Kerster; siblings John, Beatrice, Mark (deceased), Lucie, and Amy Mayeux; also survived by nieces Joy Dewing and Melissa Dolan and nephew Justin Dolan. 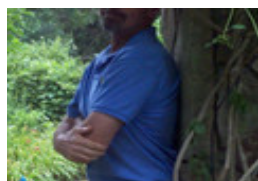
