



## Ned Lentz Solenberger II

October 12, 1944 - February 20, 2023

Ned Lentz Solenberger II, 78, laid down his working tools on February 20, 2023, in Fairfax, Virginia. He was the loving husband of Katherine B. Solenberger. They shared over 51 wonderful years of marriage together.

Born in Washington DC, he was the only child of Ned Lentz Solenberger and Virginia Maye Solenberger. He graduated from Robert E. Lee High School in Springfield, Virginia. He was a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air Force, serving in Okinawa and Eglin Air Force Base in Florida during the Vietnam era. He worked at Fairfax Hospital as an x-ray technician for over thirty years following his time in the service.

He was a member of the Harmony Lodge #17 in Washington DC and Fort Hunt Skidmore Daylight Lodge #353 in Springfield, Virginia, where he rose in rank and became a Worshipful Master. He served in many areas during his years at the lodge. He was a Past Patron of the Order of the Eastern Star. He was a devoted Washington Redskins and Virginia Tech Hokies football fan. He was an avid animal lover and enjoyed watching wildlife from his window and on trips to the mountains. He cherished his dogs, including Scooter and Heidi who predeceased him. He was currently the beloved owner of a cat Miss Borden.

He is survived by his wife Katherine B. Solenberger, his sons John A. Solenberger and wife Ilene, and Matthew L. Solenberger and wife Holly, and grandchildren Savannah and Ashlyn. His cousins Tom Cashen and Pat
