



Ofc. Robert Joseph Carson, Jr.

November 24, 1944 - December 3, 2014

Retired Police Officer, DoD, Pentagon Force Protection Agency, of Alexandria, VA, went to his eternal rest on Wednesday, December 3, 2014, at 3:55am at INOVA Mt. Vernon Hospital in Alexandria, VA. Beloved husband is survived by the love of his life, his wife of 23 years, Minister L.T. Carson, 2 godchildren, 6 sisters-in-law, 5 brothers-in-law, and a host of nieces and nephews. "Robert entered into fellowship with Bethlehem Baptist Church in Alexandria, VA in April 1996. He was baptized on April 21, 1996 by then Pastor Anthony Parrish. He and L.T. moved their membership to Southern Baptist Church P&WC in March 1999, Bishop Charles H. Doom, Jr., Pastor. The Lord led them to go back to Virginia and join Agape Embassy Ministries, July 30, 2007, where his brother-in-law, Dr. Joseph A. Mills, Jr., is Pastor. Finally, the Lord led Robert and L.T. to rejoin Bethlehem Baptist Church on September 10, 2010, Rev. Dr. Darrell K. White, Pastor. He remained a member of Bethlehem until the day he went home to be with the Lord, on Wednesday, December 3, 2014."

Ofc. Carson was on duty at the Pentagon on 9-11, when the terrorists attacked. With the help of his fellow Pentagon Police Officers, he quickly directed people to safety. Ofc. Carson served 46 years of federal service, a first in his Department, including honorably serving 4 years in the U.S. Marine Corps. A viewing will be held at Bethlehem Baptist Church, 7836 Fordson Rd., Alexandria, VA on Monday, December 15, from 10AM until time of service at 11AM. Interment immediately following at Quantico National Cemetery; repast

at Bethlehem.
