Robert "Scott" Smith, known affectionately to those who loved him as Scott, Dad, and Pop Pop, passed away suddenly and unexpectedly on May 8, 2026, at the age of 68.

Born on November 7, 1957, in Washington, D.C., Scott was raised in Falls Church, Virginia. He attended St. James Elementary School and Bishop O'Connell High School, where he formed lifelong connections and values that guided him throughout his life.

Scott was the beloved husband of Debra Smith – The love of his life, with whom he shared 45 years of marriage. Together, they built a family that became the center of his world. In addition to his wife Debra, he is survived by his sons, Ash (Ashley) and Bradley (David); and his four grandchildren, Tucker, Peyton, Madison, and Oliver, who brought him immeasurable joy and pride.

He showed his love by consistently showing up for those he cared about through every season of life. Scott possessed a larger-than-life personality and a presence that could light up any room.
