LCDR Ronald "Ron" E. Otto USN (Retired) died peacefully at Inova Fairfax hospital in Fairfax, Virginia on July 11, 2016 at the age of 82. Ron is survived by his wife of 57 years, Geraldine Otto, of Alexandria, Virginia, sons Douglas Otto of Virginia Beach, Gregory Otto of Fairfax, Virginia and daughter, Kristen Otto-Moya of Chattanooga, TN, and sister Leah Rae Schibur, of Edina, MN, and numerous cousins, nieces, and nephews. Ron was preceded in death by his parents, Raymond and Nettie (Strandt) Otto of Wales, WI, brother John Otto of Waukesha, WI, and nephew Andrew Otto of Waukesha, WI. Born July 25, 1933 in Tomah, WI, Ron joined the junior ROTC in high school and the U.S. Naval Reserve Officers' Training Corps at the University Of Wisconsin. His shipboard duties were upon the USS Snyder as a Naval Supply Corps Officer during the Vietnam war. He earned an MBA, and lived his passion teaching computer sciences at the Department Of Defense Computer Institute. Upon his retirement from the Navy after 20 years of service, Ron entered the private sector as a senior analyst and consultant for CACI, Metters Industries and Booz-Allen-Hamilton continuing his passion for working with military systems. He had amazing flair when superbly pairing wines with excellent foods. Forever the hardcore Green Bay Packers "Cheesehead," Ron generously

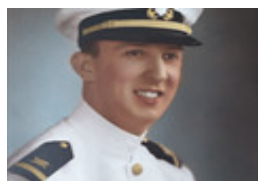
