A well respected nine year veteran of the Fairfax County Police Department, Ryan served as a Patrolman and Patrolman First Class at the Franconia District Patrol Division and Neighborhood Patrol Unit/Selective Enforcement Team, and most recently as a Patrol Sergeant at Sully District Patrol Division. As a highly accomplished Police Officer, Ryan earned a Fairfax County Police Department Meritorious Service Award in 2009 and the Fairfax County Police Association Officer of the Year Award in 2010.

Ryan is a graduate of Thomas A. Edison High School in Fairfax County, he received his Associate of Science Degree from Northern Virginia Community College, and was most recently pursuing his Bachelor of Arts in Global Affairs with a Minor in Arabic at George Mason University.
