“ *My dad, Samuel B. Stanley, Jr. was a great dad! He wanted me to speak at his funeral, which I briefly did, but I wanted to share exactly what he said in Sept. when I visited him. He asked me to sit down and write the following: " He was named after his dad, born on Oct. 28.1921 and raised in Spotsylvania, Va. He had two older sisters, Dorothy & Virginia. He went to a one room, grade school, & graduated from Robert E. Lee H.S. in Spotsylvania. There were no jobs when he graduated, so he worked for the railroad(his dad's gang) approx. 1 1/2 yrs. at 42 cents an hr. on March 20, 1940. Then went to work for civil service (DOD) retired May 23,1983, worked at Unified Industries for 12 years. Then totally retired & helped my mom. He met my mom, Violet Waite in Fredericksburg, married, and had 3 children." I would describe my dad as a dedicated husband and father,dependable and reliable."
