As a youth, Ted joined the Tennessee National Guard for three years. As soon as he was able, he began serving his country in the Air Force for a four year tour. In 1957 he graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree from Murray State University in Kentucky. While working as Professor of Military Science at McNeese State University in Lake Charles, Louisiana he earned his Master of Education degree. Along with his early service, Ted spent 22 years serving in the U.S. Army and after a distinguished career, earning the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Bronze Service Stars, Vietnam Campaign Medal and the Vietnam Cross of Gallantry, he retired as a Lieutenant Colonel.

Even though he spent many years serving our country, his servant's heart went first to his wife, Sue and his children and their families and extended too many others in his communities at his different station during his Army career.

He has served his God and his church faithfully for many years at Groveton Baptist Church.
