Vera Delores Dove of Franconia, Va. passed away in her home unexpectedly on March 28th, 2022. Born in Alexandria on June 12, 1944. Delores was one of six kids born to the late Earl William Taylor and Vera Estelle Taylor(Holloway). She was preceded in death by her husband of 54 years, Lester V. Dove Sr.

They had two children Lester V. Dove Jr.(Tina) and Sharon M. Hester (Ben). Five grandchildren that she loved so dearly, Daniel Dove(Fiancé Chloe), Victoria (Tori) Hester, Timothy (Timmy) Dove(GF-Siera), Brandon Hester, and Gabrielle (Gabby, Ellie) Hester.

She met her husband Lester at the Franconia Volunteer Fire Department where she was a lifetime member of the Ladies Auxiliary and a Majorette who would perform in the Fireman's parades and events twirling her baton and was even known to twirl fire. She was queen of the Franconia Fire Department in 1964/65 timeframe and was involved with events within the firehouse. She used to love to bowl and was active on several different leagues with friends and family and traveled for tournaments with them. She had a love for Elvis and jewelry too. She loved to shower others with gifts through the years and especially her grandchildren that she loved to spoil! She helped to care for each one of her

grandchildren when they were growing up and was always active in their lives. She was looking forward to her oldest grandchild getting married in the fall and starting his family. She also loved to travel but didn't get to do much of it as she got older due to her knees causing problems. When her husband was diagnosed with a brain tumor in May of 2019, she was there to take care of him being confined to a wheelchair until his death in March 2020. She was starting to get out and enjoy life once again post-covid and unexpectedly passed on March 28th. Delores will be greatly missed by all.
