Vernice Vaughn Fulmer, 98, of Annandale, Virginia, went home to be with the Lord on Mother's Day, Sunday, May 14, 2023.

Vernice was born on July 11, 1924 to the late Judson and Gennie Coalson in Phil Campbell, Alabama. She was the fourth of seven children, with three brothers and three sisters.

Vernice was married to John Hursel Vaughn on December 27, 1941 and became an Army wife traveling to France and other states during John's active military career. In February of 1945 they welcomed their only daughter, Sharon to their family.

John and Vernice moved to Annandale in 1960. In 1965 she was employed as a secretary for F.W. Harris Plumbing and Heating, working until she retired in the 1990s. She found her true joy, however, in serving the Lord as a Sunday School teacher and being involved in church in any way possible. She particularly loved to sing in the choir. Over the years she attended Immanuel Baptist Church, was a charter member of Fellowship Baptist Church, and eventually attended Ox Hill Baptist Church.

After being a widow for over nine years following John's death in 1984, she fell in love with an old friend, Robert Brunson Fulmer. They were married on

April 3, 1993, blending their families and living a happy life together until his passing in 2016.

Vernice is survived by her daughter Sharon (Dwight); her stepdaughters Rosemary Purple and Dianne Till (Dan); her grandchildren Kirk (Sarah), Heather (Sean), and Rebekah (Derek); her step grandchildren Jennifer, William (Michelle), Robert (Julie), Cherie (David), Darryl (Renee), and Sarah (Daniel); and many wonderful great grandchildren.
