On September 21, 2015, Virginia Kane "Ginny" Beale passed away at her home. She is survived by her husband of 70 years, Frank D. "Bill" Beale and her two children, Thomas Beale and Anne Beale as well as several nieces and nephews. Born in South River, NJ, Ginny grew up in New Brunswick, NJ, and was a resident of Alexandria, VA since 1950. From 1966-1974, she worked for the National Trust for Historic Preservation as the Supervisor of School Tours at Woodlawn Plantation. In 1976, Ginny co-founded and was President of Doorways to Olde Virginia, a tour company, in Alexandria, VA. A tour guide for over 34 years and a former Vice President of the Guild of Professional Tour Guides of Washington, DC, Ginny achieved the designation as Master Tour Guide. For over 38 years, she was a volunteer at INOVA Mount Vernon Hospital in Alexandria, VA, and was a co-manager of and buyer for the hospital gift shop.
